LANGUAGE SKILLS

The ability to express oneself orally, conveying thoughts and ideas clearly and effectively.

• Reading:

The ability to understand written text, including extracting information, interpreting meaning, and analyzing content.

• Writing:

The ability to communicate thoughts and ideas in written form, including organizing thoughts, constructing sentences, and using appropriate language.
